On Dec. 3-6, the Capital University Conservatory of Music will present its annual Christmas Festival, featuring the Chapel Choir, Choral Union, the Women's Chorus, The Chordsmen and a variety of instrumentalists. This festival is a long-standing holiday tradition enjoyed by the university, its friends and the greater Columbus community.

All students, faculty, staff, emeriti and retirees will have an opportunity to receive one complimentary ticket, plus purchase up to nine additional tickets before the general public ticket sales begin. Complimentary tickets will be available three days only – Oct. 26-28. General ticket sales will begin Nov. 2. Phone orders will not be accepted until Nov. 9. Tickets are \$20 for adults and \$10 for students and senior citizens (age 62 and older). A \$2 handling fee will be processed per order for purchased tickets. (No handling fee for complimentary tickets.) Please note, there are no ticket refunds or exchanges, and there is a limit of 10 tickets total (including the complimentary ticket) per purchase during both the advance and general ticket sale.

Christmas Festival ticket sales will be handled through Capital's box office, located in Mees Hall. Please use this form to order tickets by mail or at the box office. Box office hours are 10 a.m.-2 p.m., Monday through Friday. Checks should be made payable to Capital University. Please send a self-addressed stamped envelope for mail orders. For additional information or to order tickets by phone beginning Nov. 9, call 614-236-6938.

The Thursday and Friday performances will be preceded by a buffet dinner at 5:30 p.m. in the Harry C. Moores Campus Center. The dinner is \$21 per person and attendance is by reservation and prepayment only. If you would like to purchase dinner tickets, call 614-236-6200 or use the separate form on the back of this flier. Space is limited; dinner tickets will be sold on a first-come basis. Make checks for the buffet payable to Capital University, with the memo "Christmas Festival Dinner." Tickets will be mailed after payment is received.
